1 Total Youth Population¹ = 83,104

- Ages 10-14 - 38%
- Ages 15-17 - 26%
- Ages 18-19 - 36%

2 Teen Pregnancies¹ = 713

- Ages 10-14 - 1%
- Ages 15-17 - 29%
- Ages 18-19 - 70%

3 Repeat Teen Pregnancies¹ = 267

- Ages 10-14 - n/a
- Ages 15-17 - 19%
- Ages 18-19 - 81%

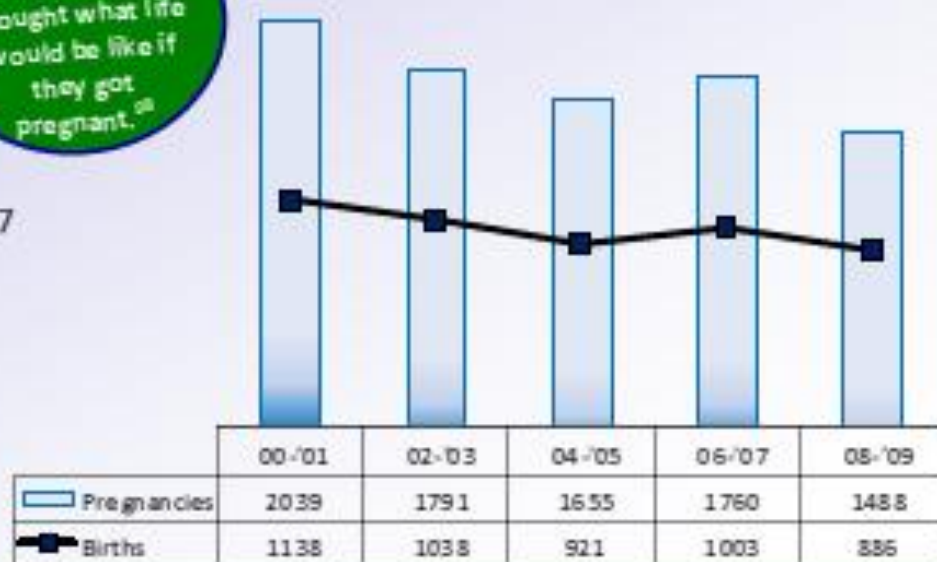
4 Teen Live Births¹ = 421

Teen Pregnancy in the United States⁹

- 1 A child has a 64%/9x greater chance of growing up in poverty if: they had a teen mother, their parents weren't married when they were born & their mother didn't have a diploma or GED.⁹
- 2 Sons of teen mothers are 2x more likely to end up in prison than sons of mothers who are ages 20-21.⁹
- 3 Children of teen parents are 2x more likely to be abused & neglected than children born to older mothers.⁹
- 4 Planning for college lowers the risk of teen pregnancy.⁹
- 5 Teen drop-outs are more likely to become pregnant & have a child than peers who stay in school.⁹
- 6 The leading cause of drop-out for teen girls: pregnancy or being a teen parent.⁹
- 7 Teens who are more involved in their school are less likely to get pregnant than peers who are not involved.⁹

Perceptions, Influences & Messages in the United States

- 1 31% of teens say parents have the most influence on their decisions to have sex while 43% of adults believe their children's friends do.^{9A}
- 2 75% of teens do not think admitting virginity is embarrassing.^{9B}
- 3 73% of adults & 37% of teens wish youth got more information about both abstinence & contraception.^{9A}
- 4 While 43%-69% of 13-24 year olds believe that doctors routinely test for various STDs, only 1/3 of doctors actually do.¹³
- 5 65% of girls & boys and 61% of parents admit when it comes to talking about sex, parents send differing messages to sons vs. daughters.^{9B}
- 6 61% of boys, 57% of girls & 74% of adults believe teen girls often receive messages that attracting boys/looking sexy is one of the most important things girls can do.^{9B}
- 7 58% of boys, 66% of girls & 75% of adults believe teen boys often get messages that they are expected to have sex.^{9B}
- 8 60% of sexually experienced teens wish they waited longer to have intercourse.^{9B}

Teen Violence

- 1 1 in 5 teen girls who have had a relationship say their boyfriend threatened harm/self-harm when they tried to end the relationship.^{9(USA)} 10% of students overall reported physically violent relationships.^{5(USA)}
- 2 HS girls reporting dating violence were 4-6x more likely to have been pregnant than peers who had not experienced violence.^{9(USA)}
- 3 Teens reporting a history of sexual abuse were more likely to have been pregnant & more likely to never/rarely use birth control/condoms.^{9(USA)}
- 4 7-8% of students report being physically forced to have sexual intercourse when they did not want to.^{5(USA&NY)}
- 5 For every 100,000 teens, the suicide rate is 6.2.^{3(Co)}
- 6 476 youth between the ages of 9-18 years old were the victims of maltreatment or abuse; 91% of the cases were maltreatment.^{2(Co)}

Fact USA:
32% of HS students were involved in a physical fight within the year.⁵

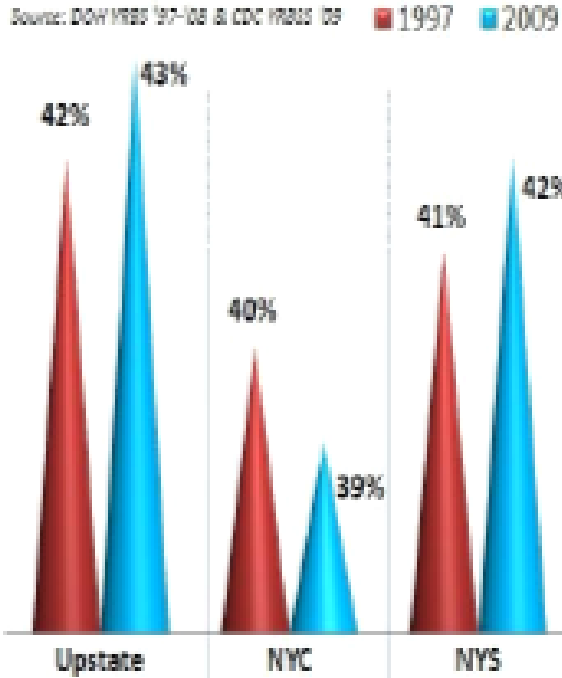

Sexual Activity in New York State⁵

- 1 32% of NYS HS students are currently sexually active.
- 2 Almost 50% of NYS & Upstate HS students report they have had sexual intercourse.
- 3 13% of HS students have had sexual intercourse with four or more persons during their life.
- 4 22% of sexually active youth did not use condoms the last time they had intercourse.
- 5 93% of youth did not use condoms with another form of birth control to further prevent pregnancy the last time they had intercourse.
- 6 6% of teens have sex before age 13. Of these teens, males (9%) are more likely than females (3%). Hispanics (14%) are more likely than Blacks (11%) who are more likely than Whites (3%).

STDs in SCNY: Chlamydia & Gonorrhea ('08)

(Table only reflects data for Chlamydia)

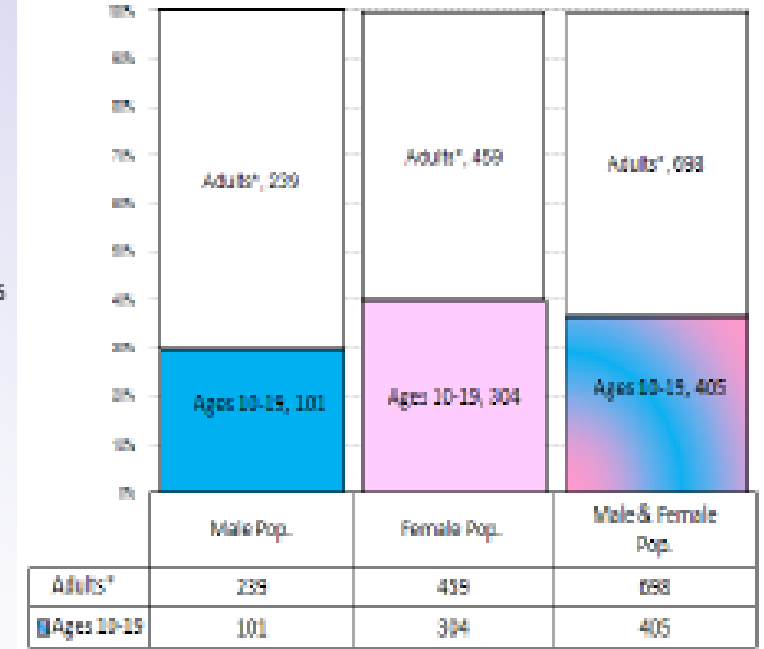
- 1 Teens comprise 37% of the Chlamydia cases & 28% of the Gonorrhea cases for the total population ages 10 years or older.¹⁶
- 2 Adolescent males comprise 30% of the Chlamydia cases & 20% of the Gonorrhea cases for all males ages 10 years or older.¹⁶
- 3 Adolescent females comprise 40% of the Chlamydia cases & 35% of the Gonorrhea cases for all females ages 10 years or older.¹⁶

Fact USA:
15-24 year olds represent 25% of the sexually experienced population but nearly half of new STDs.¹¹

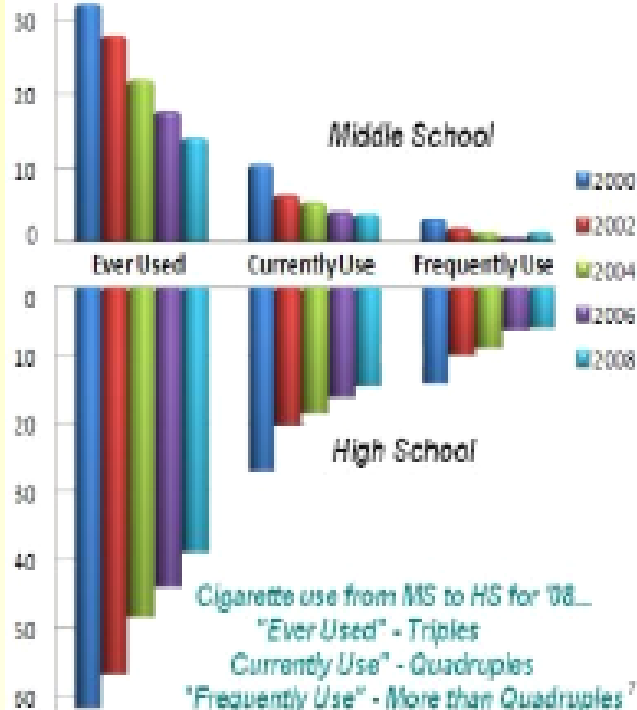
SCNY County Chlamydia Prevalence 2008*

Substance Use By HS Students in NYS

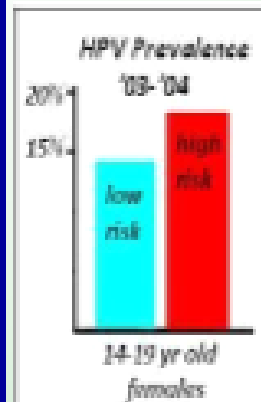
- 1 **Smoking Cigarettes⁵**
 - NYS - 15%
 - Upstate - 17%
 - NYC - 8.4%
- 2 **Binge Drinking (within the month)⁵**
 - NYS - 25%
 - Upstate - 27%
 - NYC - 14%
- 3 **Using Other Drugs (during their lifetime)^{5b}**
 - Marijuana - 35%
 - Inhalants - 11%
 - Cocaine (any form) - 7%
 - Methamphetamines - 5%

Fact USA:
22% of HS students reported drinking alcohol or using drugs before last sexual intercourse.⁵

Fact USA:
26% of HS students "felt sad or hopeless" on a regular basis & it stopped them from participating in usual activities.⁵

Human Papilloma Virus (HPV)* & Genital Herpes (HSV)* in the US

- 1 Condoms do not fully protect against HPV & HSV.¹¹
- 2 74% of the 6 million new genital HPV cases annually occur in 15 to 24 year olds.¹⁴
- 3 25% of 14-19 year old girls have HPV.^{10(Chart)}
- 4 HPV is the most common STD. At least 50% of sexually active people get it in their lifetime.¹¹
 - 5 1 in 5 people have genital HPV; 1 in 4 women & 1 in 8 men.¹¹
 - 6 Teens 15-19 who have had sex have the highest STD rates of any age group in the country.¹⁵
 - 7 Young people are the least likely to obtain medical care & therefore the most likely to suffer lifelong consequences.¹⁵
